

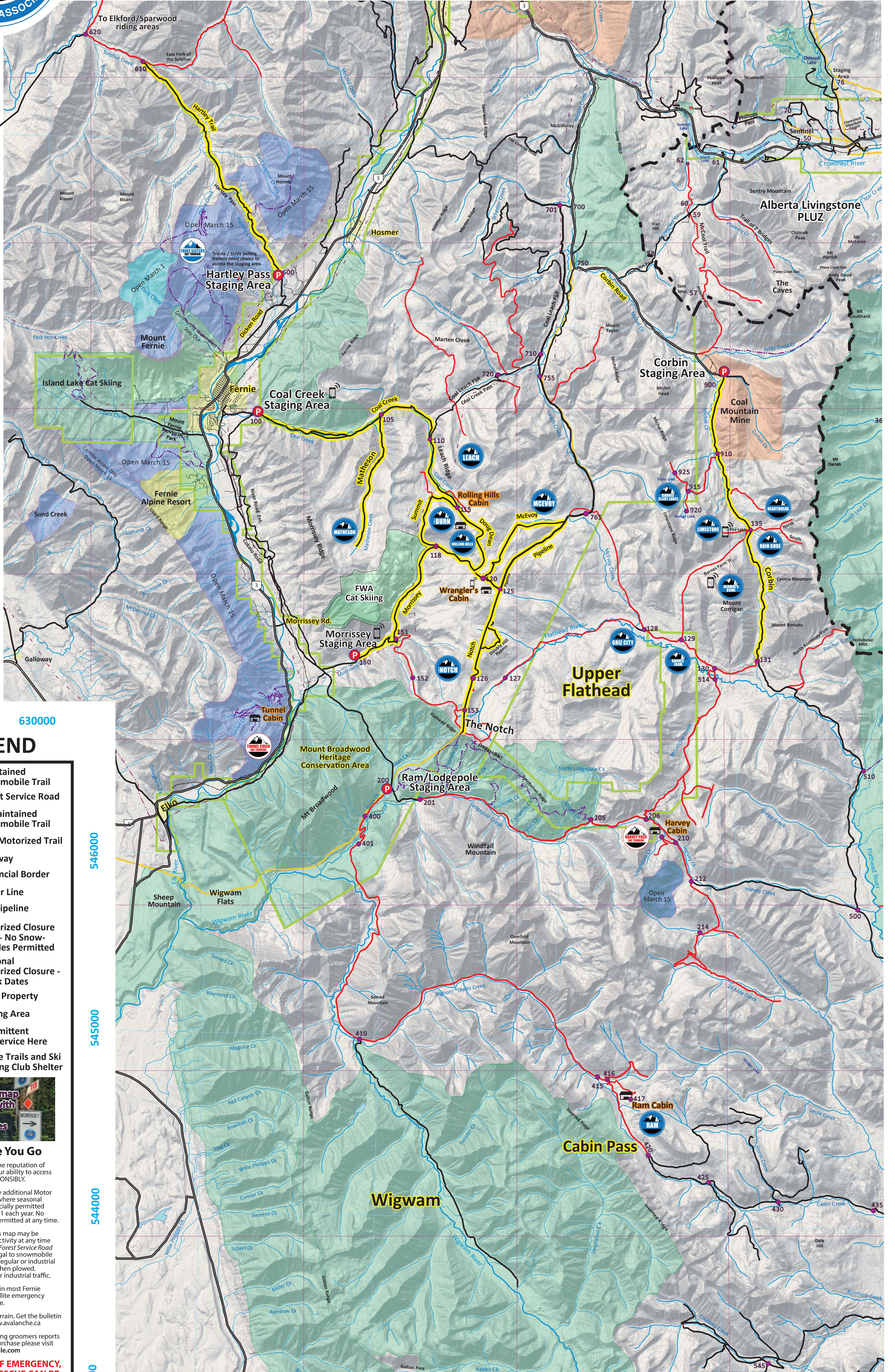


# FERNIE SNOWMOBILE ASSOCIATION MAP

### Know Before You Go

- YOUR actions impact the reputation of motorized users and our ability to access these lands. PLAY RESPONSIBLY.
- The Elk Valley has many additional Motor Vehicle Closure Areas where seasonal snowmobile use is specially permitted between Nov 1 - May 31 each year. No other motorized use permitted at any time.
- Any road or trail on this map may be plowed for industrial activity at any time without notice. Under Forest Service Road Use Regulation, it is illegal to snowmobile on plowed road fit for regular or industrial vehicle use. Keep off when plowed. Do not block hauling or industrial traffic.
- There is no cell service in most Fernie riding areas. Carry satellite emergency communications device.
